Parents can expect Horris Hill's excellence in care, provided in a modern, purpose-built and fully-equipped facility. Girls and boys are given an abundance of opportunities to explore and develop both indoors and within our 65 acres of countryside.

WHY A NURSERY EDUCATION?

A nursery education has benefits for young children, as it can help with development and early education. We believe it helps children in the following ways:

- **Children learn new skills.** children will learn a wide range of new skills, from language and physical skills, to early understanding of subjects like maths, sciences and technology. We hope parents will notice their child's skills develop during their time at our nursery.
- **Children's social skills.** A nursery enables your child to learn to socialise with other children and adults, which aids their successful development. Learning how to listen to others, solving disagreements and talking about your feelings will be learned at the nursery.





- **Making friends.** When your child joins Horris Hill Nursery, they are in the perfect location to begin forming friendships with other children. They will be surrounded by those of a similar age, and can make connections with the use of role play and group games. Research has shown that this is the most important thing a child has to learn in order to be happy and develop in their life.
- **Extracurricular activities.** We love to offer a wide range of extra activities and experiences for your child to discover.
- **Preparation for school.** When your child joins the Horris Hill family in our Nursery, this is their first step in developing them as they move through to the main school. The nursery helps the children through the steps to provide them with the skills to be ready to start school.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- Each term the nursery offers a range of weekly extracurricular activities. These help to vary your child's days, keep everyone active and ensure there is never a dull week!

NURSERY FEES AND FUNDING

- Places are all year round for 50 weeks per year (closed Bank Holidays, Christmas week and INSET days).
- Fees are due for all other absences.
- Children must attend for a minimum of 4 sessions (half a day = 1 session) or 5 sessions if claiming the extended Early Years Funding entitlement.
- Our fees include all meals, snacks and drinks.
- We supply wipes and nappies.

EARLY EDUCATION FUNDING

Children aged two (those that are eligible) and all those aged three to under five are entitled to early education-funded sessions. Early Education Funding (EEF) is available from the term beginning after a child's third birthday. Some two-year-olds may also be eligible for EEF; please speak to a member of staff for details.

CHILDCARE VOUCHERS

We are registered with many companies that provide childcare vouchers as an alternative way to pay part of your fees. Please inquire at the nursery for more information.

REGISTRATION FEES

There is a non-refundable registration fee of £180.00, payable at the time of reserving a place for your child.

DEPOSITS

There is a deposit payable upon acceptance of a place of £350.00. The deposit will be refunded in the month following your child leaving nursery in line with the Nursery Terms and Conditions.

SETTLING IN SESSIONS

Before your child starts at Horris Hill Nursery, we will invite you and your child to attend a minimum of two settling in sessions. These help you and your child to get to know your allocated nursery practitioner, and the other team members and children at the nursery.

They also help your child to get used to short periods of time at the nursery before building up to a full session. We ask you to help us gather as much information about your child as we can during these sessions.
